

EPP HEADS OF GOVERNMENT DISCUSS ENERGY

The Heads of Government and leaders of the European People's Party (EPP) reviewed today a document on energy, which was adopted in February by the EPP Political Bureau.

The document includes proposals for a more sustainable, efficient and secure energy policy:

**The EPP advocates an overall strategic objective in the EU regarding energy, but recognizes that each Member State chooses its own energy mix*

**The EPP advocatess an increased use of renewables in areas such as electricity production, transportation, heating and cooling*

**The EPP proposes that the EU invests more into renewables*

**The EPP supports the idea of saving at least 20% of total primary energy used in the EU by 2020*
