The European People's Party (EPP) heads of state and government and opposition leaders, along with the Presidents of the Commission, Council and Parliament – **Jose Manuel BARROSO, Herman VAN ROMPUY and Jerzy BUZEK**- will be meeting on 25 March 2010 in Brussels for the regular EPP Summit hosted by EPP President **Wilfried MARTENS**.
