Hungary: EPP congratulates sweeping victory of Fidesz in municipal elections

The President of the European People's Party (EPP) **Wilfried Martens** congratulated Fidesz and its leader and EPP Vice President **Viktor Orbán** for the sweeping victory in yesterday's municipal elections in Hungary.
