Poland: EPP President congratulates Bronislaw Komorowski for winning first round of Presidential elections

Brussels, 21 June 2010



The President of the European People's Party (EPP), **Wilfried Martens**, congratulated this morning Polish Presidential candidate **Bronislaw Komorowski** for winning the first round of Presidential elections with over 41% of the vote. There will be a run-off election on 4 July.

"I would like to congratulate Bronislaw Komorowski for scoring a very strong result and winning the first round of Presidential elections. I am convinced that in the second round, a majority of Polish citizens will give him their trust since it is clear that he is the candidate with the leadership qualities and the political gravitas that can bring Poland forward," the EPP President underlined.
