



Call for entries - logo competition EPP 35th anniversary

The European People's Party (EPP), founded in July 1976, is pleased to announce a competition for a logo design for the **35th anniversary of the EPP**.

The winning logo will be presented at the special EPP anniversary event in May 2011 in Brussels. The logo will be used on EPP website, and official publications throughout 2011.

1. The subject of the competition is a logo design for 35th anniversary of the EPP
2. Everyone is free to participate.
3. Competition details
 - the design must be inspired by the current logo of the European People's Party (to be found under (<http://epp.eu/media.asp?z=5B5858>),
 - the design must include the indication of EPP's 35th anniversary (can be text-based, logo or any combination of these and other graphic formats)
 - the design must be able to be printed in -black and white- as well as in full color
 - the size must be adjustable from very small to large (it must be possible to use it on screen: internet, TV , video and banners ; on paper : in newspaper print, letterhead, cards, advertisements, posters; and on textile or various gadgets)
4. Submission
 - the works should be prepared in a high resolution (300dpi), you are asked to forward a lower resolution copy per email as well as send the high-resolution images through You SendIt service (<https://www.yousendit.com/>) or other similar service.
 - the low resolution entry should be send to **epp35@epp.eu**
 - in the email please include your name, mailing address, email address, and telephone number
 - designer identification should not be on the logo itself
 - every designer can participate with a maximum of 3 works
 - each work should be forwarded in a separate e-mail
 - you will receive a receipt of your work by e-mail
5. Key dates
 - the competition opens on 17 March 2011
 - submissions close at midnight 17 April 2011 (Central European Time)

- the winners will be announced on 2 May 2011

6. Shortlisting:

-an internal EPP jury will shortlist max. 5 entries which will be available for public view;
voting on the best shortlisted proposal will take place on EPP's facebook page (facebook.epp.eu)

7. Prize

-the designer of the winning entry will have an option to choose between:

-an invitation to participate as special guest at the EPP Congress in Marseille (December 2011)

- a 3-months paid internship at the EPP HQ in Brussels

8. Authorship

-only entries with a declaration of authorship will be accepted,

- please add in your email the following statement:

“The design is my own creation and has been developed in conformity with the competition’s guidelines.”

(competition’s guideline:

the design shall not in any way infringe any third party’s right, including but not limited to copyright, logos, trademark, trade names, or other proprietary rights of publicity or privacy.)
